A few reminders:

- ◆ Please be brief at drop off & pick-up. Linger-ing can be disruptive to the classroom rou-tine.
- ◆ Ensure that your child has a complete change of clothes.
- ◆ Label ALL personal belongings.
- ◆ Never leave a child in the car unattended. (Fl. law)
- ◆ Please hold your child's hand while in the parking lot and only park in designat-ed areas. **Do not** avoid the speed bumps.
- ◆ Remember to contact the office or your child's teacher if your child will be absent.
- ◆ If you send a lunch that includes a "peanut but-ter alternative" please indicate such so the teacher doesn't return the item.

School will be closed Mon-day, September 30 in ob-servance of Labor Day.

There is no school on Mon-day, September 30 in ob-servance of Rosh Hasha-nah. We will be open that day, however, you must sign up for "camp". The sign up sheet is on the front bulletin board. The daily rate is the same for the 2's and 3's. The cost for VPK students is \$25/day. We also accept siblings up to the age of 11 at a cost of \$25/day. You will receive a 10% discount for sib-lings.
